1.) ENROLLMENT

Every student must have registration at the Departamento de Assuntos Acadêmicos e Financeiros – DAAF (Department of Academic and Financial Affairs).

2.) LIVING EXPENSES

3.) REGISTRO NACIONAL DE ESTRANGEIRO (RNE)



The National Foreigner Registration (RNE) is a document that all foreigners who remain in Brazil for more than the time limit (90 days) allowed by law must have, registering at the Polícia Federal (federal police) located at the Aracaju Airport.

4.) CADASTRO DE PESSOA FÍSICA (CPF)

The Individual Taxpayer's Registry (CPF) is another identification document that registers the person in the Brazilian Federal Revenue Service (RFB). This document can only be requested after the appearance in the Polícia Federal (federal police) and the receipt of the number of the National Foreigner Registration (RNE).



5.) CARTAO MAIS ARACAJU



Students have an advantage over the issue of urban transportation in Aracaju, including international ones. Once the student has the RNE and the CPF, and is duly enrolled in Tiradentes University, he / she may request the Mais Aracaju card, which gives a 50% discount on the bus ticket prices.

6.) BUDDY PROGRAM



The Buddy Program is a program in which Tiradentes University students volunteer to assist international students who will study at the institution. The Buddy will participate in social and academic orientation activities, which take place throughout the year, specially designed to integrate international students.

7.) DAAF

The Department of Academic and Financial Affairs helps students with various academic services, such as enrollment in courses (on-campus and distance learning), internships, and financial matters. It is located in the Rectory Building, which serves as the main administrative body on campus.



8.) INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS OFFICE



The International Relations Office assists study abroad students, both incoming and outgoing, in various ways. We speak Portuguese, English and Spanish! It is our top priority to welcome and assist international students in Aracaju. Our office is located in Building F.

9.) JACINTO UCHOA DE MENDONÇA LIBRARY

Our Library has a vast collection of books, magazines, computers, newspapers, and cultural artifacts! Our students have full access to all materials, including scientific materials, and our “study spaces” with computers for accessing digital papers and journals.
